The Families of the German Reformed Church, Warner Twp. Clark Co., WI

The information about the families of this church were supplied by the families and compiled by those members. The approximate time frame is the early to mid 1900's. In most cases, the father's name is listed, followed by his parent's names and then the mother's name, followed by her parent's names. The Bauman brother's families associated with the West Side Church was one of many families who had roots in Clark County, but chose to move from the county to live elsewhere in the United States. There were two Bauman brothers who were married with children, as members of the West Side Church. This file contains information on the brothers, their parents and their siblings.

Parents are Carl¹ Alexander and Sophie (Ziesel) Baumann. Carl was born 1/9/1844 in Saxony, Germany emigrating to Wisconsin in 1853 with his parents and siblings. The 1860 census list Carl (15) living with his parents Frederic (66) and Caroline (48), siblings: Anton (20), Frederica (17), Amelia (6), Frederic (2) and Johanna (10 months) living in Herman, Sheboygan, WI. In 1870 Carl A married Sophia Ziesel in Sheboygan Co., WI. Sophia was born 9/10/1851 in Wisconsin. Sophie's parents were Augustine (1813-1867) and Agatha (Steimie) (1825-1875) Ziesel. Carl (36) and Sophie (29) were living in Herman, Sheboygan WI according to the 1880 census with children: Bertha (9), John (7), August (6), Mina (4), Frederick (2) and Emma (8mo). The 1900 census lists Carl (56), Sophie (Laphia) (49), Fred (22), additional children Herman C (18) and Lena A (16) living in Herman, Sheboygan WI. Sophie passed on 3/28/1905, buried at Saron UCC Cemetery, Sheboygan Falls, Sheboygan, WI alongside her husband, Carl who passed on 11/20/1909. This information was found at findagrave.com.

The 1930 census lists John (57), wife Caroline (55); daughters Elsie A (20) and Emma C (26) living in Walla Walla, Walla Walla, WA. The 1940 census lists the same members of the household and location as the 1930 census. A 1931 city directory for Walla Walla WA lists John CJ as a carpenter, living at 110 Delmas Ave.

The 1900 census lists August (26), wife Matilda (21) living in Eaton, Clark, WI with her parents, Christopher (46) & Margaret (45) Kippenhan; her siblings Johnnie N (19), Idina (17), Clara (15) and Oscar (10); servants Louis Decker (24) and Frederick Schwarze (32). The 1910 census lists August (35) and wife Matilda (31) living in Dawson Co., MT. The 1920 census lists August (45), wife Matilda (42) living in Richland Co., MT with their children Ruth (6) and C. Walter (3y-10mo.)

The information on Walter was found in family trees researched on Ancestry.com. The census records for 1920 do not indicate Walter H was a son of August and Mathilde. There are death records for indicating birth/death years, but no listing of parents. This information needs further investigation to verify Walter H is indeed the son of August and Mathilde.

Frederick T. Baumann, 74, died at his home at 39 Nein Ave., Plymouth, Sunday after a six months' illness. Mr. Baumann was born Oct. 14, 1877, in the town of Herman, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Baumann. On May 21, 1904, he was married to Miss Martha Schmidt. They lived in the town of Herman until 1916 when they moved to their present address. His profession was bee keeper and basket weaving.

Survivors are his wife, one son, Lester, at home; two brothers, Herman of Sheboygan and August of Montana; also one sister, Mrs. Joseph Thuermer of Mt. Calvary. One brother and two sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at the Wittkopp Funeral Home, Plymouth. The Rev. H. W. Baxmann will officiate.

Herman Baumann, 77, passed away at Sheboygan Memorial Hospital early this morning after bring in ill health for the past year. He had been making his home with his son and daughter-in-law at 1833 N. 19th St.

Born in the Town of Sheboygan Falls on May 14, 1882; he was the son of the late Carl and Sophie Baumann.

On June 6, 1908, he was united in marriage to Clara Selle. His wife preceded him in death in 1934.

Mr. Baumann was engaged in farming near Plymouth and was also active in carpenter work most of his life, having retired 12 years ago when he moved to this city and has resided here ever since.

Survivors are one son, Edgar, of Sheboygan; two daughters, Mrs. Herman (Irma) Eckmann in France, and Mrs. Leonhard (Margaret) Kassel of Milwaukee: 10 grandchildren, one brother, August, of Sidney, Montana, and one sister, Mrs. Joseph Thuermer of Mt. Calvary, Wis. Two brothers and three sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. on Friday at Nickel's Funeral Home. The Rev. Arnold Wenger, pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, will officiate at the services. Burial will take place in the Sheboygan Falls Cemetery.
